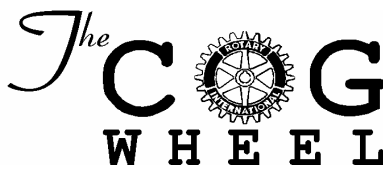

### Last Program

Our guest speaker was Dr. Harlan Beckley, Chair of the Shepherd Poverty Program at Washington & Lee University. He explained the Shepherd Poverty Program's mission as one where *"Professionals of all levels learn how their work and civic life relate to poverty and how to work to make a positive difference"*. Students can obtain a minor degree by completing three levels of study. A) Focused course study, B) Completing a summer internship and C) Writing a thesis relevant to issues of poverty in their professional lives.



The Shepherd Program has formed strategic alliances with other colleges and universities throughout the country. This consortium of schools greatly broadens access to the program and adds to the diversity of disciplines involved. Imagine teaching a lawyer, an educator, a manufacturer and so on how to interact and work to defeat poverty. The Shepherd Program seems to embrace the essence of what being a Rotarian is all about.

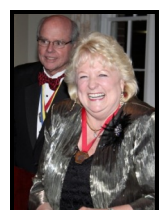
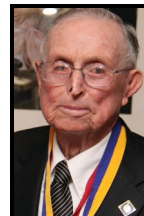

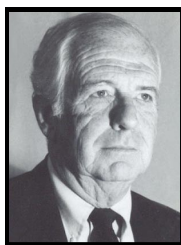
