Our Program Last Week

Sean Wohltman, the Chief Geospatial Scientist at Google, described the work he's leading (and has led) at Google through the LongView Program and through past work for the National Geospacial Intelligence Agency.

When Sean first began working for Google, he thought he'd be hunting terrorists, but within his first week on the job, Hurricane Katrina hit New Orleans and his work quickly shifted to helping coordinate relief services. The relief workers in New Orleans were using antiquated systems, resulting in such delays in information gathering that lives were literally being lost due to slow download speeds. That experience energized Sean to use Google's resources to make mapping and other essential services more efficient and effective.

Google now has an entirely independent outreach group (www.google.org) that coordinates services such as People Finder app to help disaster victims and their loved ones connect after (and during) a crisis. The company has also assisted in monitoring the Afghanistan elections and crises in Haiti, Japan and the Philippines.


