Last Meeting

We were treated to a new member talk by Osborne Abbey. Born in Bradford PA, once known as the "coldest spot in the nation", Osborne had an idyllic growing up. Near High



School graduation he realized that he was expected to go to college. Being a Presbyterian, he had an inside track to Waynesburg College, where he earned a BA in Psychology, and minored in Philosophy. Uncle Sam had plans for Osborne after his college graduation, and drafted him to serve in Viet Nam. He chose the Navy, figuring it would be safer on a ship firing at shore, rather being on land where the bullets were flying. He ended up on land, at Cam Rahn Bay, and received a battlefield promotion. As reward for being in harm's way, his next assignment was in London.

After completing his military service, Osborne began a career in education. His early work was with autistic children. He advanced through the education system, from teacher, to administrator, to superintendent. Along the way he earned Masters and Doctorate degrees in education from Columbia University. With 27 years in the education field, Osborne joined corporate America, and learned about EBITDA and how Wall Street works. His most recent position was as CEO for a non-profit, Valley Forge Educational Services.
