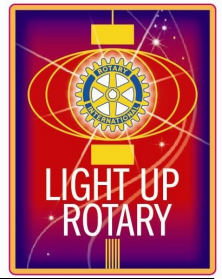
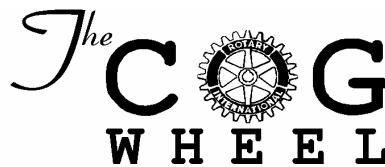

One Rotarian volunteered back stage at the Winchester Little Theater from 1953 to 1976. His wife directed 14 plays; worked the front desk as well as back stage for 53 productions. Kudos to **John and Marjorie Lewis!** Marjorie currently chairs the restoration campaign.



Our Last Program

Presentation by Ken Lauziere, former fire chief of the U.S. Capitol & former member of Warrenton Rotary Club.

As a member of the capitol police command group, Ken helped Congress to continue functioning under adverse conditions. He was responsible for preparing to combat fires, as well as other hazards. Ken designed the first threat detection system and served as a senior consultant for FEMA and other congressional committees. No matter where his travels took him, he kept a 6 a.m. phone appointment that reviewed the threat assessment for the day.

Closely involved in the safety design of the National Capitol Visitors Center, Ken was responsible for ultimately signing the occupancy certificate. With 580,000 sq. feet dispersed across three levels of underground space, the Center ran three times over its projected budget, resulting in a \$631 million dollar outlay. Finally on December 2, 2008, the new Center opened on the 145th anniversary of the placing of the Statue of Freedom on the Capitol dome.
