OUR LAST PROGRAM Paul Magness, in his new role as president of the Rotary Club of Winchester, described how it is an honor to serve. Together with his wife, Molly, Paul moved to Winchester 10 years ago and they now enjoy the lively company of their 3 children.

Paul's father exemplified the values of "Duty, Honor, and Country." Their family's military service dates back to the Revolutionary War and extends to the war in Afghanistan



with some family members awarded Purple Hearts. His father, although injured in Vietnam, helped to raise his youngest son and sought to serve family, the poor, and those less fortunate. His father helped to create a school for environmental studies at West Point.

Like his father, Paul believes in this country and in its diversity. He has assisted in the rebuilding of the Rescue Mission and accompanied a mission trip to Haiti. A military friend of his father's, Dick Kent, introduced Paul to Rotary. Paul believes in God, the force of love, and the power of giving. Paul's upcoming goals are manifold. He wishes to honor the service of military veterans who have exemplified "service above self." He would like to build on the foundational efforts of Julia Connell, Scott Arthur and Don Butler to address the opioid epidemic. A 2018-2019 District Collaborative Grant of \$24,000 will help to establish a 12 person Ray of Hope House for those suffering with substance abuse. In addition, the fight to eradicate polio will continue and a new effort to confront Alzheimer's Disease, the 6th largest cause of death in the U.S., will be added to our efforts. Projects concerning youth are likewise forthcoming.

Winchester is the model community; like the Centennial Light in CA, which has shone for 117 years, Rotary's efforts are still burning while giving back. Paul is grateful to the past presidents, current officers, incoming Board members and his wife. He looks forward to a fantastic year ahead and challenges us to *"Be the Inspiration."*
