Rieman Royston, sister of Carrie Claytor, is our District the things we think, se Foundation Advocate and she spoke to us on the Rotary International Foundation's focus on eradicating polio from the face of the earth.

December 20, 2018



Polio has been recognized as a disease since 1894 but really was brought to the forefront in the 1930's when it became an epidemic. Typical treatment was to isolate the patient to prevent the spread of the disease and later the iron lung machine was developed which saved many lives. In 1950 a vaccine was developed and a worldwide effort was made to vaccinate every person in the world. Great progress was made but the disease still existed and people were still becoming infected. In 1979 Rotary joined the fight and in 1985 help fund a \$100 million vaccination effort. The vaccination program was so successful that the disease was completely eradicated from the USA in 1994. However 4 countries in the world still are considered susceptible to contracting polio. There have been just 22 cases of polio reported this year and while this is great progress we cannot celebrate until there are zero cases. To that end Rotary remains a leader in its partnership with Bill Gates to vaccinate and eradicate this horrible disease in the remaining 4 countries. help as a Rotarian is key as each dollar you donate towards this effort is matched twice. Please give generously so that this scourge can forever be absent from the earth.


