Club reserve/checking is \$44,000

Rotary Charitable Foundation has \$30,000. \$50,000 maintained is recommended

Distributed \$102,000 to our community last fiscal year Global grant of \$52,000 designated to supporting substance abuse prevention

End of last fiscal year saw a deficit of negative-\$866, when we planned for a surplus of \$1,825 (missed our mark by \$2,691)

This year's budget plans for only \$760 above expenses Money distributed to beneficiary is broken down as follows:

All funds are held for 45 days

Following the 45 days...

25% remains in case of unexpected cost

65% goes to the beneficiary

10% goes to the Club fund and must be requested via email from Charitable Foundation to maintain consistency with distribution policy.
